

Mexico Shipping Point Trends

October 7, 2025

Unless otherwise stated, shipments, crossings, or imports are for the weeks ending September 20, 27, and October 4, 2025, in that order, in thousand hundredweight (cwt) or 100,000-pound units. The expected movement is for the period of October 5 through October 18, 2025. Prices are for Monday, October 6, compared to Monday, September 29, 2025, unless otherwise stated. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry, and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on products of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated.
