

# Mexico Shipping Point Trends

**October 15, 2025**

Unless otherwise stated, shipments, crossings, or imports are for the weeks ending September 27 and October 4 and 11, 2025, in that order, in thousand hundredweight (cwt) or 100,000-pound units. The expected movement is for the period of October 12 through October 25, 2025. Prices are for Tuesday, October 14, compared to Monday, October 6, 2025, unless otherwise stated. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry, and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on products of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated.
