Unless otherwise stated, shipments, crossings, or imports are for the weeks ending September 6, September 13, and September 20, 2025, in that order, in thousand hundredweight (cwt) or 100,000-pound units. The expected movement is for the period of September 21 through October 4, 2025. Prices are for Monday, September 22, compared to Monday, September 15, 2025, unless otherwise stated. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry, and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on products of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated.
